# 5-Day a week Lab Based (Family) w/ Academic Blended Learning

## Schedule

- All students will be issued a laptop/device.
- Internet access is a family responsibility.
- Staff will wear facial coverings as required by current guidelines.
- Classrooms will be arranged to accommodate social distancing 3'-6' guidelines.
- Hand sanitizer and/or hand washing stations will be available in each lab, classroom, and high traffic areas.
- Sharing of materials will be minimized. When necessary, materials/tools will be sanitized using approved sanitation wipes or solution that is effective against COVID-19.
- Staff and students will receive training on health protocols.

# Remote Learning

## Schedule

- School buildings will be closed to students.
- Staff may or may not report to building depending on current guidelines.

## Teaching & Learning

- Instruction will be 100% online.
- Students will be required to complete assignments and following the daily online attendance and check-in procedures.
- Internet access is a family responsibility
  - Wi-Fi will be available in the KCCC parking lot.

## Health & Safety

- The decision to implement 100% remote learning will be based on the health and safety of students and staff.
- Recommendations and requirements from the CDC and local health officials will play an integral role in the decision.
